## Pastor's Letter

The first few verses of the Gospel of John are a Christmas reading, assigned to the second Sunday of Christmas, when the calendar allows for a second Sunday of Christmas. Take a moment to read John 1:1-14. Unlike Matthew, who talks about Joseph and magi; unlike Luke, who talks about Mary, and shepherds, and angels; unlike Mark, who skips over Jesus' birth and jumps right into to John the Baptist...John gets cosmic.

The opening lines of John are meant to echo the opening lines of Genesis: "In the beginning." God is doing something new in the Word made flesh, in the birth of the Messiah, the Son of God. And, at the same time, God is constant: creating life, redeeming all of creation.

Another echo of creation and newness happens in the 21<sup>st</sup> chapter of Revelation: "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, 'See, the home of God is among mortals. He will dwell with them; they will be his peoples, and God himself will be with them and be their God; he will wipe every tear from their eyes. Death will be no more; mourning and crying and pain will be no more, for the first things have passed away.'"


Once again, one year is about to draw to a close and another year is ready to begin. We give thanks for all that has come before; all that God has done; all of our blessings. We give thanks for the birth of Christ, and for God's love, grace, and salvation that entered the world through Jesus. We give thanks for God's

presence and guidance in our lives and in our world, and we pray for the promise of Revelation, for an end to pain and tears, to come about now, in and through us, even if only in part.

We ask God to come down now, in this Church, in this people, in this congregation, in our hearts, for this creation. For the darkness to never overcome the light, and for the light to shine in and through us. We ask for God to hold until the pain and tears will be no more; we ask God to strengthen us when challenges crop up in the new year; when the challenges of this year linger. We ask God to give us power to truly be children of God. In the end, as Revelation says, God is the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end; no matter what has come, or what may come, we are held in God's love and power.

Let us pray: Eternal God, you have placed us in a world of space and time, and through the events of our lives you bless us with your love. Grant that in the new year we may know your presence, see your love at work, and live in the light of the event that gives us joy forever—the coming of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.



## Meet Messiah's Mutual Ministry Team

The Mutual Ministry Team's primary function, according to the constitution and by-laws, "is to aid the pastor in effective congregational ministry." This takes a couple of shapes:

First, the mutual ministry team is there to receive all types of feedback from congregation members. They can also answer questions about the ministries of the pastor to the congregation. Second, they are a group that is available for the pastor to go to for counsel, or to consult as a sounding board. In short, they "assist the pastor in developing and maintaining a healthy working relationship" with the congregation.
